Signing Up

*To enroll in our **On-Line Driver Education program**, please use the select link on our website and complete the registration just as you would for any regular class.*

- If mailing in your registration, be sure to clearly mark **On-Line**.*
- If registering electronically, select the **On-Line** option during the PayPal checkout process.*

*Once your registration is received, you will receive a confirmation email with detailed instructions on how to access and complete the course assignments. If availability allows payment for the program will be due at the time of your student's **first scheduled driving lesson**. If you have any questions or would like to check availability before registering, you are welcome to call **(402) 320-1804**.*

Course Requirements

*Students enrolled in the **On-Line** program are required to complete all **video assignments** along with the questions found in the **Chapters**. These requirements meet the **same standards as our in-class curriculum**.*

*Upon successful completion of both the coursework and the required driving instruction, students will receive their **Nebraska Provisional Operator's Permit**, just as they would in a traditional classroom setting.*

Driving Instruction

*All students are required to complete a **minimum of 3 hours of behind-the-wheel instruction**. Additional driving time may be needed depending on the student's experience and comfort level.*

- Most students complete their driving phase in **under 5.5 hours***
- Additional costs apply only if more than 5.5 hours are required*

*Driving lessons are scheduled by **phone, email, or in person**.*

*Students who live within **10 minutes of Elkhorn High School** may be picked up at their home. Students living outside this area may be asked to meet at **Elkhorn High School (EHS)** or **Elkhorn South High School (ESHS)**.*

Assignments

*All assignments and detailed instructions will be emailed directly to the student. For the average student, the coursework typically requires **approximately 20 hours** to complete.*
